



## ACCESS PROVIDES INDEPENDENCE



Megan has the **Amesbury Locca ACCESS** system. At 22, she survived a diving accident but is paralyzed now and wheelchair bound. But, with the donation of an ACCESS system from Amesbury Locca, she is now able to come home to her own apartment and let herself in. She unlocks the door with a Sure-Touch remote and simply pushes the door open with her wheelchair.

Megan loves her new independence and offered this, "The **LOCCA** has really made a difference in my day to day life. I can come and go as I please with the press of a button. I couldn't work my old keys at all, so now all I have to do is press and push the door. I can get into my apartment by myself or let someone in without any trouble."

*Modifications include: Electric Strike in Jamb, and Control Unit mounted near the door & plugged into a standard wall outlet. No modification to the door slab. Latch locking handle required for this system.*
